2 Timothy 4:5-7 (ESV) ⁵As for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry. ⁶For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come. ⁷**I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.**

1. Fight the _____!

- **Ephesians 6:10-13 (NLT)** ¹⁰A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. ¹²For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places. ¹³Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm.
- **The Bottom Line:** Fighting the good fight requires putting on good armor.

2. Finish the _____!

- **Hebrews 12:1-3 (NLT)** And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us. ²We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith. Because of the joy awaiting him, he endured the cross, disregarding its shame. Now he is seated in the place of honor beside God's throne. ³Think of all the hostility he endured from sinful people; then you won't become weary and give up.
- **The Bottom Line:** There really is no better race than the race God has set before you.

3. Keep the _____!

- **Luke 9:23-24 (NLT)** ²³Then he said to the crowd, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must turn from your selfish ways, take up your cross daily, and follow me. ²⁴If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake, you will save it.
- **The Bottom Line:** You have to be intentional to keep the faith.
